HIRE360 is excited to announce that the doors are now open to our workforce initiative - supporting access to union construction careers throughout the Chicago's communities that are most in need. Our knowledgeable team provides trades readiness programming that includes test preparation and assistance; money to buy boots, books and tools for apprenticeships; case management services; referrals to jobs; and support throughout the apprenticeship process. HIRE360 will expand to offer job services in other unionized fields like manufacturing and hospitality sectors in the coming months. For small and emerging businesses, HIRE360 offers mentoring and a loan pool to help Minority- and Women-owned firms grow.



Since January, HIRE360 has reached over 5,000 interested candidates with almost 2,900 individuals completing an application for our program. Eligible candidates were invited to attend one of more than twenty orientation sessions we've held since January 23 to learn more about our trades readiness programming. Orientation participants have been paired with one of our eight case managers to develop individualized plans to help attain a building trades career.

We continue to offer ongoing orientations with evening options included. Later this month we will begin our test prep classes to prepare candidates for the upcoming aptitude tests held by most of the union apprenticeship schools. HIRE360 will also facilitate an orientation for returning tradespersons where participants will learn about our career prep and retention supports, including opportunities to connect with contractors for open positions.
