We would like to extend a very special thank you to the<u>Bosch Group</u> for support of these new apprentices, who will receive a starter set of power tools to provide them continued success in their apprenticeship. To further prepare our candidates for success as they embark on their career journey in the trades, HIRE360 has partnered with <u>United Way of Metro Chicago (UWMC)</u> to host mock interview sessions for our candidates.
