The Hospitality Industry is Ready to Make a Come Back and HIRE360 is Here to Help

The eight-week program launched earlier this week and serves a diverse group of students, many of whom had been laid off from their jobs due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The program is taking place at McCormick Place and will prepare students with skills needed for the return of

the hospitality industry.

Sponsored by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) and the Apprenticeship Illinois expansion and workforce alignment initiatives, the UHCHI Culinary Apprenticeship program will serve as a key pipeline to connect community members with career opportunities available at McCormick Place and throughout the Chicago-area hospitality industry

Initiatives like this are critical to the growth and success of Chicago's hospitality industry and HIRE360 is proud to be part of this effort to support UHCHI and to expand the model of apprenticeships to new industries!
