The <u>Teamsters Joint Council 25 Apprenticeship Program</u> will be opening up this summer for candidates interested in a career as a Construction Driver. Construction Drivers operate heavy trucks to deliver and move important supplies and materials on construction sites throughout Illinois. Through the Teamsters apprenticeship, you'll get eight weeks of training, including Class-A CDL License training with the endorsements that you need to operate heavy trucks on job sites, as well as forklift operation, safety, and other skills.

If you have a clean driving record and are interested in a career as a construction driver, HIRE360 is here to help by providing you a letter of recommendation, assistance with your application and provide other resources to get you ready for this trade. Teamsters are taking applications by appointment only – so reach out as soon as possible for more information about getting started! HIRE360 is conducting one-on-one meetings with the 85 diverse businesses we are working with to scale up. The objective is to identify needed technical assistance and update individualized action plans that will assist in their growth. The Technical Assistance Action Plans (TAAP), will provide coaching and referral services that include:

- Business feasibility and viability, and construction industry specific information as well as referrals to bid opportunities and appropriate business professionals for estimating, minority certification, back office, financial assistance.
- Business strategy and management including execution, marketing, sales, business expansion, public relations, information technology, social media, improved efficiency, human resources, workforce issues, business acquisition, and business succession.
- Assistance in the areas of financial strategies, financial analysis, financial management/reporting, help with financial application processes and access to capital.
- Business compliance, business specific safety manuals and bid prequalification, environmental rules and regulations, business registration and filing requirements, IRS, OSHA, and other state and federal governmental regulations.

President Obama Surprises Local
Business Owners During A Visit To A

In his first visit to Chicago since 2019, former President Barack Obama surprised a small group of South Side business owners on Tuesday to engage them about the forthcoming presidential center.

To help recruit women, young people and the formerly incarcerated, the



workforce initiative is partnering with the Chicago Regional Council of Carpenters, Chicago Women in Trades (CWIT), HIRE360, IBEW-NECA Technical Institute, Revolution Workshop and St. Paul's Community Development Ministries. And to help, the foundation is putting in \$850,000 to train 400 new apprentices from the city's South and West sides. Money will also go toward stipends for things like transportation, child care and union fees.
