HIRE360 and Chicago Teachers Union Foundation Partner for Conversation Around Youth in Trades

HIRE360 is joining a series of webinars on the topic of "Preparing Chicagoland's Next Workforce" with the Chicago Teachers Union Foundation. This series of conversations will emphasize the importance and challenges of helping young Chicagoans see paths forward into great careers. HIRE360 led off this discussion with a conversation about the opportunities in the building trades for young people.

HIRE360 was joined by leaders from the Electricians and Carpenters Unions, as well as Clark Construction, who shared their stories ascending to positions of leadership in the industry. Building Trades apprenticeships programs are an important pathway upwards, and we are proud of our partnership with CTUF ensuring that young people across Chicago know that this is a real opportunity.

CTA Red-Purple Bypass Opens, HIRE360 Candidates Help Make it Happen

The CTA announced last month that the <u>Red-Purple Bypass would open</u> as a permanent main line track. The first train rolled over the bypass on the morning of November 19th. HIRE360 is proud to have placed a number of candidates on the job site, including Laborers, Carpenters and other candidates. HIRE360 Candidates are already achieving landmarks in Chicago's skyline and infrastructure and we could not be more proud of them! HIRE360 congratulates these candidates and our partner CTA for this great accomplishment.

Business Development

2021 Business Development Highlights

HIRE360's Business Development Center has made tremendous progress in

the last year. We have 92 minority subcontractor companies that we are scaling up and increasing their capacity to bid and win contracts on upcoming projects such as the Obama Presidential Center, The 78, the O'Hare Airport expansion, etc. by providing technical assistance that includes:

- Back- office capacity in bookkeeping, estimating, marketing, branding, management, bonding, and compliance
- Grants for financial analysis
- 20 companies approved for or in process for loans totaling \$7 million
- 42 companies secured assistance from the COVID-19 CARES Act totaling near \$4 million in 1st and 2nd PPP Draws
- 11 companies became union employers
- Assistance for minority certifications and renewals as W/M/VBE, DBE, BEP was provided to 31 businesses.

We were among only a handful of organizations in the U.S. awarded pro-bono support from JPMorgan Chase to build a platform of digital tools and processes that will help us to identify and track the most important metrics for increasing business capacity and the economic impact on the businesses.

In September, Crain's Chicago Business featured our Center in itsstory about Vanessa Rhodes, owner of Twenty Eleven Construction. With our support, she was able to join three unions, secure financing, and win a contract with the CTA's Red/Purple Line Modernization project. "Programs like Hire360 are leveling the playing field for small-business owners like me. With its help, I'm optimistic that we're going to be one of those top firms pretty soon," she says.
