Training Center Taking Shape

HIRE360 Receives \$3 Million Investment for South Side Training Center



We are very excited to announce a major investment on our new home from the state and federal government. We were joined by <u>Governor J.B. Pritzker</u>, <u>Congressman Raja Krishnamoorthi, Chicago Federation of Labor President Bob Reiter</u>, our Board Chair <u>Don Biernacki</u> as well as leaders from government, labor and business across Chicago. The investment will help us build out permanent facilities to host our pre-apprenticeship program, our small business incubator, and a full culinary and hospitality apprentice training center. "HIRE360 will serve as a multifaceted space for workforce development throughout the Chicago area," said Governor Pritzker at the event.

"This business development center... will provide people with middle-class, life-sustaining job skills," said Congressman Krishnamoorthi. The facility will include a parent's center and playroom for working parents, a solar training

center, full service kitchens for culinary apprenticeship training with UNITEHERE Local 1, and more. We thank Governor Pritzker, Congressman Krishnamoorthi and all our partners in business, government and labor for their support in making this historic investment! And a big thank you to Adrian Mobley - Owner/President at Air & Wellness Safety Training Company and David Castrejon - IBEW Local 134 Apprentice who talked about the supports HIRE360 has given them to help them achieve their potential.
