The GBNN has connected nearly **4,200** Greater Bronzeville residents ages 16-55 to jobs that contribute to living-wage in the last 4 years.

However, as the coalition has grown, the emphasis has evolved to be broader, as we want to increase access to community programs beyond workforce development and offer a more expansive and interconnected way to deliver social services.

Access and awareness is at the center of work, our programs and training help equip Greater Bronzeville residents with skills, education, and training that lead them to in-demand career opportunities.
