Sophia Irizarry, a 31-year in her first year as <u>aLaborer</u> apprentice, dedicated single mother of a 5-year-old son. Raised in the Pilsen area, she previously held positions in retail, reception and as an event assistant before making a transition to the construction industry. Inspired by a family member who was a union <u>Electrician</u>, Sophia was motivated to explore the trades. Driven by her desire to secure a better life for her son, she took the step to join the trades and was sponsored into the Laborers in July 2022.

Sophia came to HIRE360 to get employment and financial assistance after she was laid-off. Today, she participates in the monthly Mentorship Meetings to network with contractors and other trades workers. She feels, "They (HIRE360) have provided an outstanding networking pool and have introduced us to so many important individuals in our industry. They have also helped me financially with gear needed for work. They have helped me build friendships with other trades men and women. It's nice to talk to other tradespeople who understand the daily ins and outs of our careers."
