We're Expanding Statewide!



Success Story: Marco A. Salinas

Marco A. Salinas, a 24-year-old resident of the Southwest Midway area in Chicago, embarked on a remarkable journey that led him from heavy equipment certification to becoming a roofer apprentice.

Marco's quest began two years ago when he attended ATS in Wisconsin to become heavy equipment certified. His goal was to secure a well-paying job in a union company, but he faced challenges due to the need for personal connections in the industry.



Undeterred, Marco persevered and explored alternative paths to kickstart his career. By the age of 20, Marco had entered the mechanical field, driven by a desire to understand vehicles thoroughly. His knowledge allowed him to avoid costly repairs by diagnosing issues with his own vehicle. Growing up, Marco lived in the 26th and Albany area, but his family eventually moved to Midway Airport, where they purchased a house.

Marco attended Dawes Elementary and later graduated from William J. Bogan high school. Even during high school, he worked to earn his own money. His first job was at McDonald's at the age of 16, followed by a stint at Portillo's when he turned 18. Determined to transition into construction and labor, Marco persisted despite lacking initial knowledge in the field. But that all changed once he came across HIRE360 through an online search.

After attending his first orientation session with HIRE360, Marco quickly learned the value of having a case manager guide him through exploring the various unionized construction trades and their respective application processes. After exploring several different trade opportunities, Marco knew the Local 11 Roofers was the perfect fit for him. Just last month, Marco secured a position as a Local 11 Roofer apprentice and is already gaining valuable on-the-job experience.

Marco expresses gratitude for the chance to pursue his dream job. He now looks forward to a fulfilling career as a roofer apprentice. His message to others: "Godspeed to all who apply for their dream jobs." Marco's journey exemplifies resilience, adaptability, and the power of seizing opportunities. We wish him continued success in his new role!

Success Story: Kyle Irvin

Kyle Irvin, a 39-year-old father of five, was raised on the South Side of Chicago. He graduated from Dunbar Vocational Career Academy in 2003, specializing in brick masonry. However, in 2005, life's challenges led him down a difficult path, resulting in a prison sentence. After serving his time, Kyle worked diligently as a delivery driver for two restaurants, determined to turn his life around.

In 2024, while watching television, Kyle saw a news segment about HIRE360. Inspired by their mission, he decided to



return to his high school roots and reignite his passion for the trades.


Kyle joined HIRE360's Take Charge Electrical Vehicle cohort, a partnership with <u>ComEd</u>, where he engaged in test preparation, financial literacy workshops, tools workshops, and resume workshops. He toured the Electricians trade school and ComEd, and earned several certificates, including Flaggers, Fall Protection, Scaffold & Hazard Awareness, Rigging Hazard Awareness, OSHA 10, and CPR & First Aid.

During a tour of <u>IBEW Local 134</u>, Kyle told his case manager that he joined HIRE360 because he "wants to make something of himself" and hopes to inspire his eldest son to join the trades through HIRE360 as well.

Kyle's involvement in the Take Charge Electrical Vehicle cohort provided valuable networking opportunities, leading to his sponsorship within the Local 76 <u>Laborers</u>. He has been a Laborer for a month now and is very happy with his decision, embracing a brighter future for himself and his family.

Bricklayers:

• Bricklayers create architectural works of art with stone and tile. As with all trades, you should be prepared to work hard, outside and at heights on a regular basis to succeed in this trade. Applicants will be accepted throughout the year. Applications will be available Monday through Friday between 8:30 am to 3:00 pm at the DCTC office or online at www.bac2school.org. Secure your spot by applying today.

Electricians IBEW 134:

• Electricians assemble, install, maintain, and test electrical equipment and wiring systems in residential, commercial, and industrial settings. The apprentice program is five years in duration, and is registered with the U.S. Department of Labor, Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training. The program consists of on-the-job training provided by union electrical contractors, and related classroom instruction. **Apply before August 7**th to secure an aptitude testing date this year.

• As a Union Carpenter, your essential responsibilities include constructing, repairing, and installing various structures and fixtures made of wood and other materials. You'll work with precise measurements, cut materials, shape components, and assemble them according to specified plans and designs. Applications opening September 9.

• The vital work of the International Association of Heat and Frost Insulators and Allied Workers has saved energy, saved money, and saved lives. Heat and Frost Insulators Local 17 offers an excellent five-year apprenticeship program that is now open for online applications.

The Cook County Small Business

<u>Source</u> is an award-winning program that strives to support, grow and elevate small business, the backbone of Cook County's economy. This program directly connects small business owners with expert guidance and resources needed to take their businesses to the next level.



Providing Access, Fostering Growth

Among the organizations joining the Small Business Source this year is HIRE360. On July 23rd, Cook County hosted a Referral Partner Onboarding session to allow existing and new partner organizations the

opportunity to get to know each other and learn about the variety of small business services that they each provide. The session was led by Domini Gamble, Senior Program Manager. HIRE360 was represented by Dave Thomas, Manager of Business Development and Supply Chain.

The Network

The Cook County Small Business Source convenes a network of leading Business Support Organizations (BSOs) to provide direct support to the Cook County small business community. By partnering with trusted organizations, the Source connects small business owners with the expertise they need to succeed. Among the BSOs that are a part of the Source are Allies for Community Business, Chicago Minority Supplier Development Council, Women's Business Development Center, the Chicago Southland Chamber of Commerce, and many more. HIRE360 is among a group of organizations called "Specialty Partner" organizations because of their connection to the construction industry, and particularly clean energy construction projects.

Cook County funds most of the grants and services related to the Cook County Small Business Source with support from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). In addition, the program receives support from the State of Illinois Community Navigator Program, We Rise Together, and the Fund for Equitable Growth.
