



PROGRAM DESIGN & GOAL

The Climate Works Pre-apprenticeship program is designed to increase the number of qualified construction and building trades apprentices and prepare them to enter full apprenticeship programs on their way to careers in construction and the building trades.

ELIGIBILITY

- People 16 and above
- Reside in an equity investment-eligible community OR be formerly incarcerated OR be a current or former graduates of the foster care system.
- Have a high school diploma or GED/HiSET or be in a program to get one.
- Have an interest in a career in construction & building trades.

SUPPORT SERVICES

Support services, based on participant need, may include:

- Childcare/family care
- Transportation assistance
- Driver education fees
- Math and reading tutoring
- Housing assistance
- Mental health counseling

STIPENDS

Receive \$13/hour for your participation in the training program.
