### **Success Story: Robert Romo**

Roberto Romo, a 34-year-old Latino male from Cicero, Illinois, is married with two children. Raised in a predominately Latino neighborhood, Roberto is the second youngest of eight siblings. His father worked long hours, while his mother was the primary caregiver. Growing up in a full house and a rough neighborhood, Roberto faced many challenges but never got involved in gangs. His parents lived paycheck to paycheck, unable to afford their children's desires. Determined to progress in life and earn good wages for his family, Roberto pursued various trades, from body shops to serving. His skills



ranged from making a Skinny Margarita to performing an oil change. Despite his efforts, Roberto struggled to pass the aptitude tests for the Pipefitters and IBEW Local 134 apprenticeship programs. However, his journey took a positive turn when he discovered HIRE360 through Instagram. After attending one of HIRE360's weekly orientation sessions, Roberto knew this was the path forward for him.

He participated in the HIRE360 Take Charge EV Pre-apprenticeship Program in 2024 and gained valuable skills and certifications. During his time in the pre-apprenticeship program, Roberto was able to learn more about the different apprenticeship programs. Working closely with his case manager, Roberto identified his goals and interests and learned about the Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council Apprentice

With the support of the Take Charge pre-apprenticeship program, Roberto successfully applied and passed his aptitude test. He took full advantage of HIRE360's prep courses, test prep sessions, and supplemental study materials to prepare for the aptitude test he initially failed. He has been accepted into the Local 1027 Mill-Cabinet Program from the Mid-America Carpenters Regional Council.

Roberto now feels he has found his career and continues to receive assistance from HIRE360 as he progresses in the trades. He is grateful for the support and guidance that has helped him achieve his goals.

# Renewable Energy Contractor Clinic

Last month, HIRE360 hosted a "Renewable Energy Contractor Clinic" at its new training facility located at 2540 S. State Street, in Chicago. The free event included presentations on how to register as an Equity Eligible Contractor (EEC), and how to participate in the Illinois Shines and Illinois Solar for All programs. More than 50 attendees learned how to access free business advising and small business resources from the Cook County Small Business Source, an overview of grant



opportunities from the Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity (DCEO), and information on working capital loans, certification support and other no cost resources for contractors that HIRE360 provides.

The presentations covered excellent information on the EEC certification program and requirements along with explanations of the categories of Approved Vendor, Subcontractor, and Designee. There was feedback given on the various pre-construction grants available as well as the gap funding through the Illinois Finance Authority. The surveys received from the businesses involved will enable us to continue the process of obtaining and conveying updated information as needed. We welcome inquiries and will provide any assistance and connections to businesses that are interested in projects in the clean energy industry.
