Electrical Trainee Helper program with <u>IBEW 134</u> in May 2023. Balancing his job at <u>Maron Electric Company</u> and raising his four children as a single parent was no easy feat.

One of the biggest challenges Terrance faced was taking the aptitude test for electricians. However, with the support of HIRE360 and his dedication to studying, he passed the test in October 2024, now preparing to attend the apprenticeship program orientation.

Graduating the First Cohort of the Climate Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program in Decatur

We're thrilled to celebrate the graduation of the first cohort of the Workforce Investment Solutions Pre-Apprenticeship Program in Decatur, part of our transformative <u>Climate Works initiative</u>. This program is designed to help individuals from underrepresented communities build meaningful, family-sustaining careers in the clean energy and construction industries, creating opportunities that foster stability, purpose, and growth.

Fifteen candidates graduated in the initial cohort, with 87% transitioning into local trade unions. The cohort featured inspiring individuals like Lily Bailey, the only female candidate, and Albert Martin, the youngest participant at just 18 years old who is furthering his career with IBEW. Graduates completed the program with essential credentials, including OSHA 10 certifications, and developed soft skills like teamwork and problem-solving.
