## Success Story: Amaury Dominguez

Amaury Dominguez from Chicago's Back of the Yards neighborhood is already laying the groundwork for a career in carpentry. After working jobs in custodial services, he was eager for something more stable, and more fulfilling. That drive led him to HIRE360, where he joined the <u>Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program</u>. Through site visits, hands-on training, and personalized support such as help with applications to recommendation letters, Amaury found his fit in the Carpenters Union. Last month, he began his preapprenticeship with the <u>Mid-America Carpenters</u> <u>Union</u>, stepping confidently into the trades. With sharpened skills, new confidence, and a clear path ahead, Amaury is ready to build a future that lasts.





## Success Story: Dagoberto Castillo

After years of working as a 1099 subcontractor in unsafe environments, Dagoberto Castillo knew it was time for a change, especially with a 2-year-old son counting on him. Encouraged by a friend who found success through HIRE360, Dagoberto connected with case manager Jonathan Luviano and enrolled in the 2025 <u>Take Charge EV Charging</u> <u>Pre-Apprenticeship Program</u>. The program offered hands-on training, certification courses like OSHA 10 and Excavation Safety, and a pathway into the electrical vehicle and green energy industry. He realized that many of the practices on previous job sites weren't safe, and the program helped him gain a new understanding of what was possible for his future

Today, Dagoberto is taking the next step in his career as a new member of the Electricians Union, <u>IBEW Local 701</u>. Through Take Charge, Dagoberto also learned about <u>ComEd</u>'s pivotal role in expanding Illinois' clean energy future, upgrading infrastructure, rolling out smart grid technology, and aiming for net-zero emissions by 2050. With new skills, industry certifications, and a union future ahead of him, Dagoberto is proud to be on a path that offers long-term stability and purpose. He emphasized how this opportunity wouldn't have been possible without HIRE360 and ComED and hopes his fellow graduates can also apply what they've learned to build safe, meaningful careers.

## ICC Climate Works Cohort 3 Graduation

Over six weeks, students completed the Multi-Craft Core (MC3) Curriculum and earned certifications in OSHA-10 and CPR/First Aid. **Operating Engineers Local 150:** 

 Operate Heavy Equipment with Local 150's ASIP is a premier training program designed for today's construction professionals—including heavy equipment operators, technicians, drillers, and construction material inspectors. Work on job sites like highways, tunnels, and power plants. This union produces rock, sand, and gravel for construction. Applications are accepted online through their official website.

#### Pipefitters Local 597:

• Are you interested in becoming a Pipefitter? This union is now accepting applications for a 5-year program with two tracks: building trades pipefitter or HVAC service technician. Contact your HIRE360 case manager for application details and a letter of recommendation.

#### Roofers Local 11. Roofing and Waterproofing :

• If you enjoy working outdoors and often at heights, consider becoming a roofer and waterproofer. They perform various jobs, including applying hot and cold built-up roofing, single-ply roofing systems, shingle, tile, and slate roofs, waterproofing foundations, plaza decks, and traffic coatings, lining ponds and tanks, and installing environmentally friendly green roofing systems.

#### Bricklayers:

• Create architctural structures using stone and tile. Work outdoors and at heights. Applications are accepted year-round at the Bricklayers District Council Training Center in Addison, IL. The new class begins early next year.

#### Electricians IBEW Local Union 701 (DuPage County):

• Work with this union to install and maintain electrical systems in buildings. There is no residency requirement but most of the work is in DuPage County. There are two training programs available: commercial electrician and telecommunications electrician.

#### Sheet Metal Workers - Local 265:

• This primarily suburban work involves designing, fabricating, and installing HVAC systems, metal siding, and roofing.

#### Painters and Drywall Finishers:

• This paint work includes applying paint, varnish, and coatings to surfaces. The drywall work includes installing wall coverings and performing drywall taping and finishing.

#### Electricians - IBEW Local 176 (Joliet):

 This work involves bringing power to homes and businesses. Applications are accepted every Monday from 8 - 11:30 AM and 1 - 4 PM in Joliet.
