After working in broadcasting, real estate, and marketing, Wesley Jones Jr. was ready for a change and decided to pursue a more stable and rewarding career. Through HIRE360 and the <u>Illinois Works Pre-</u><u>Apprenticeship Program</u>, he gained the training, certifications, and support he needed to transition into the trades. With our help, he successfully prepared for and passed the entrance process for <u>Elevator</u> <u>Constructors Local 2</u> and just started as an apprentice.

Now, as an apprentice building elevators, Wesley is also helping others rise. His journey is inspiring friends and peers to take their own first steps toward union careers. "HIRE360 gave me the tools and the push I needed. That moment changed everything," he said.

First 2025 Illinois Works Graduation at HIRE360

We celebrated our first <u>Illinois Works Pre-Apprenticeship Program</u> Cohort Graduation at our Training and Business Development Center! Over the course of 9 weeks, 23 graduates from across Chicagoland gained paid hands-on experience, industryrecognized certifications, and the preparation needed to pursue careers through registered union apprenticeships. Nearly all of the graduates are considered Equity Eligible Persons under the <u>Illinois Climate and Equitable Jobs Act</u>, with half coming from socioeconomically disadvantaged areas.

• Operate heavy equipment Local 150's ASIP is a premier training program designed for today's construction professionals—including heavy equipment operators, technicians, drillers, and construction material inspectors. Work on job sites like highways, tunnels, and power plants, this union produce rock, sand, and gravel for construction. Applications are accepted online through their official website.

Heat and Frost Insulators Local 17:

• The vital work of the International Association of Heat and Frost Insulators and Allied Workers has saved energy, saved money, and saved lives. Heat and Frost Insulators Local 17 offers an excellent five-year apprenticeship program that is now open for online applications. **Deadline to apply is June 29.**

Pipefitters Local 597:

Allies for Community Business Expands Support for Small Businesses Through HIRE360 Partnership

Allies for Community Business (A4CB) is deepening its impact in Chicago's construction sector by expanding its partnership with HIRE360, thanks to new funding from <u>Wells</u> <u>Fargo's \$20 million Open for Business</u> <u>Growth initiative</u>. A4CB, a nonprofit that provides capital, coaching, and connections to small business owners, was selected as the first recipient of the national program with a \$2.5 million grant.

The funding will allow A4CB to enhance its specialized construction loan program in collaboration with HIRE360. The initiative combines flexible financing with business advisory services and mentoring—tailored specifically for small and diverse contractors looking to scale.

"Through our work with HIRE360, we've seen firsthand how targeted capital and coaching can accelerate growth for construction



entrepreneurs," said Brad McConnell, CEO of A4CB. "This grant enables us to reach even more businesses that are ready to grow but aren't quite ready for traditional bank financing."

Together, A4CB and HIRE360 are helping build stronger, more inclusive local economies by empowering underrepresented business owners with the tools they need to succeed.
